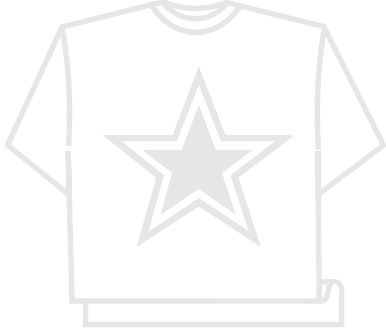
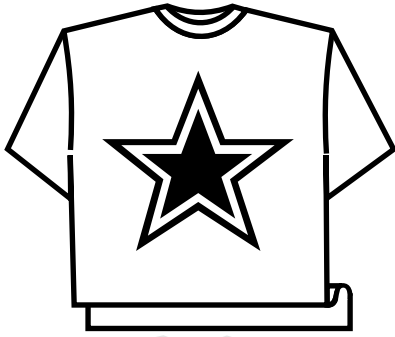


Washing Tips for Screen Printed T-shirts always read the label

- To keep your imprinted shirt looking new, always turn it inside out before washing. This reduces friction against the imprint on the shirt thus it looks new after several washings.
- Over-drying can cause wrinkles. Take shirts out while the seams still feel damp, then place on a clothes hanger to air dry. If you do over dry, toss a damp towel in the dryer with your wrinkled shirt and tumble dry, take out immediately.

We recommend 100% cotton garments for our customers who will be wearing them outdoors. Cotton is the most comfortable and the most absorbent material. 50/50 garments may not wrinkle and be lighter weight but they do retain your body moisture as well as body odors.

- When line drying, put bright colored shirts in the shade.
- ** ***Use non-chlorine bleach when bleaching is needed.*****

Stains - Ball-point Ink: Spray with hair spray, then flush with water. Put in normal wash as quickly as possible.

- Hot water will set these stains: blood, wine, milk products, eggs, wine. Pre-soak in COLD water, then wash in warm.

- Other food & beverage spills:

Dip a napkin in club soda and sponge the spot.

Instructions for washing Embroidered Garments:

~ Especially IMPORTANT for Embroidered garments being washed for the first time! ~

1. For best results, wash in warm water with a mild detergent.
2. Do not add bleaching agents such as chlorine, peroxide or sodium.
3. Do not line dry. Garments should be tumble dried at warm setting.
4. Never wring out any Embroidered garments.
5. Never leave Embroidered garments soaking in water.
6. Never leave damp or wet Embroidered garments folded or stuck together.
7. Garments commercially laundered should be Embroidered with polyester thread.
8. If the first laundering of a new Embroidered garment is done in cool or cold water, leftover dye particles from the thread may remain on the fabric.
This does not mean the article is ruined.
Re-wash in warm water. The remaining particles will wash out.
